A. Building Community Through Events

Bringing *The Akright Promise* to Life

One of ACRA's defining priorities in the first half of 2026 was strengthening community cohesion. A great community is built not only through quality infrastructure and effective governance, but also through meaningful opportunities for residents to connect, collaborate, and celebrate together.

Guided by the theme "**The Akright Promise – The Highest Standards in Everything,**" ACRA organised a series of flagship events that brought together residents of all ages and backgrounds. These initiatives promoted healthy living, civic participation, youth empowerment, family values, and neighbourly relationships, while reinforcing our shared identity as one community.

From village meetings to sporting events and national celebrations, each event was designed to foster a stronger sense of belonging and encourage every resident to play a role in shaping the future of Akright City.

1. Village Meetings

January – February 2026

Listening to Residents. Building Together.

The year began with a series of village meetings held across Akright City, providing residents with an opportunity to engage directly with ACRA leadership. These meetings reaffirmed our commitment to participatory leadership and transparent governance by creating an open platform for dialogue, feedback, and collaborative problem-solving.

2. Akright Youth Day

Driving ACRA's Digital Transformation

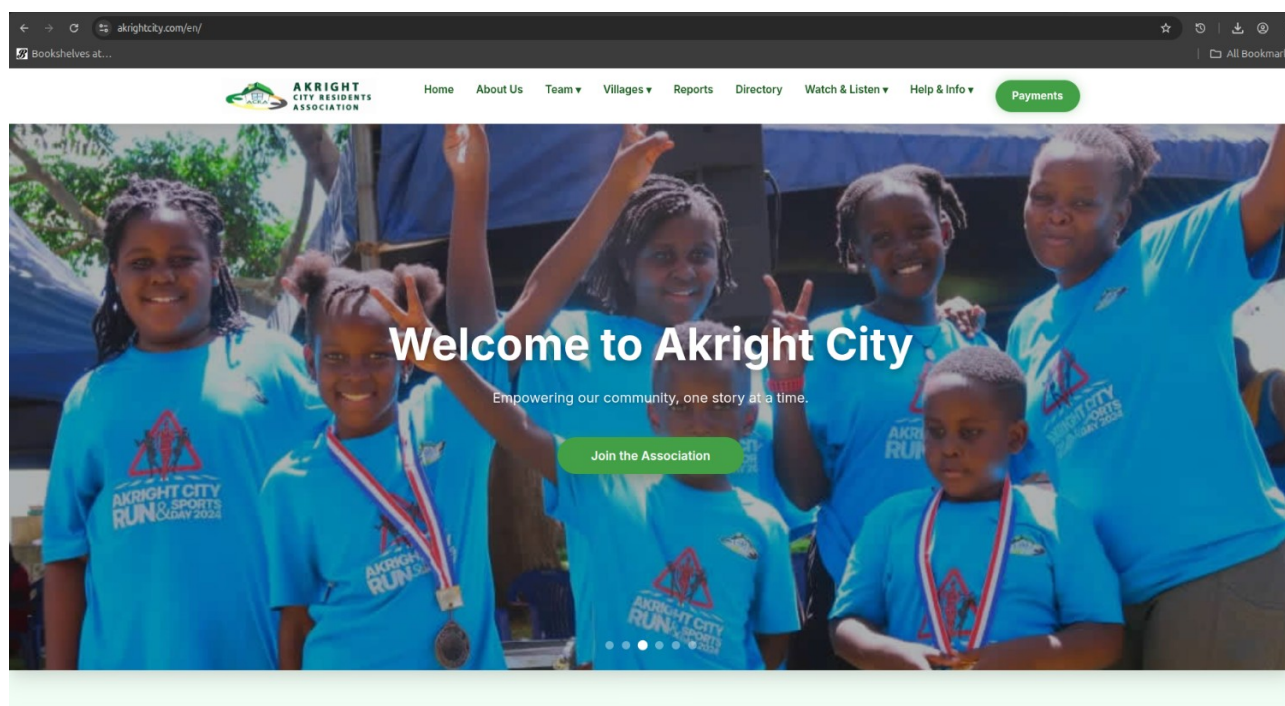

GOVERNANCE
